

Q1. How long does it take to deliver a fingerpost?

A. The majority of standard signage products may be delivered in approximately 4 weeks. However Broxap will endeavour to meet any reasonable delivery requirements.

Q2. Are you able to supply non-standard signs?

A. Yes, we are able to supply signage systems to suit our customers requirements.

Q3. Out of what types of material is a fingerpost system manufactured?

A. The fingerpost comprises of a cast section which is available in cast iron, ductile iron, or cast aluminium and a mild steel shaft section. Fingerarms are manufactured from cast aluminium, whilst finials are available in either cast iron or cast aluminium.

Q4. How many characters can be accommodated on a fingerarm?

A. A typical fingerarm will accommodate 26 characters, however, this is dependant on the size of the text required and the number of breaks between words. A member of our Sales Team will be able to offer further advice on request.

Q5. How tall is a fingerpost column?

A. The height of a finger post may be determined by our customer. The maximum height that we would normally supply is 4.5 mtrs.

Q6. Can additional fingerarms be added?

A. Yes, any number of additional fingerarms may be added by utilising column height extensions. These are illustrated in the Broxap Main Product Catalogue.

Q7. How are the fingerarms attached to the post?

A. The fingerarms are attached to the column by means of an Allen Headed Grub Screw.

Q8. How are the fingerposts fixed to the ground?

A. There are several fixing options for fixing fingerposts:

Root fixed - where the column is supplied with an extended leg for concreting into the ground.

Surface fixed - where the column is supplied with a pre drilled base plate for surface fixing, this system also allows the base plate to be submerged.

Removable - where the column may be supplied with a removable column base extension.

Q9. What sizes of display cases can be supplied?

A. Display cases may be manufactured to suit any customer requirements. The majority of display cases have a viewing panel height of 1000mm and panel widths ranging from 800mm to 2400mm.

Q10. Can a display case be internally illuminated?

A. Yes, display cases may be supplied internally illuminated.

Q11. What type of material is the glazing manufactured from?

A. We use 6mm gauge PETg for the glazing on our display cases. We are also able to offer toughened glass as an option.

Q12. Can a display case be fitted onto a cast iron fingerpost column?

A. Yes, our range of display cases may be supplied with standard mild steel posts or may utilise any of our fingerpost column designs.
