# Cast iron fixings

## Free standing

For very secure sites, indoor locations or uses which may require the seat or bench to be repositioned, seats can be left unanchored.

## Ground bolting - Leibig bolts (set of 4)

Where a solid foundation already exists, seats may be secured to the ground using bolts through the pre-drilled seat foot.

For cast iron framed seats, Liebig expansion bolts, **S-2092**, can be supplied at an additional cost.

## Extension legs (set of 4)

For most seats, extension legs, **S-2082** can be supplied at an additional cost, for bolting to seat feet and anchoring into a concrete fixing pad.


Seat legs can also be secured between paving slabs.

## Submerged fixing


The seat leg is extended and inserted directly into concrete. Diagram shows the BX 2031 Pierhead bench securely bolted to a concrete block below ground level.




Free standing.
