

Cast iron finishes/highlighting

Cast Iron seat ends have a potential lifespan of 100 years and are supplied as standard in grade 250 cast iron. Seats may also be supplied cast in grade 450 / 10 ductile iron which is inherently stronger due to its composition and therefore may be considered for use in areas where the seat may be exposed to vandalism or possible vehicular impact.

All cast iron components are finished with a primer undercoat and a 2 – pack acrylic topcoat in a range of BS / RAL Colours.

Highlighting

One or more colours can be used to highlight design detail, match existing colour schemes or to include corporate colours. At Broxap we use Ardenbrites Light Gold No. 1 which is bright, durable and has excellent colour retention. All highlighting is hand painted onto the product.

Customisation

Cast iron seat ends may also be customised to include logos crests or coats of arms to create a special corporate or public identity.

Commemorative plaques

Stainless steel plaques may be supplied with an inscription which is engraved and infilled. Plaques measure 40mm x 200mm and are rebated into the back slat of the seat.

Standard colour range

Broxap offer a choice of standard colours, however, the full BS and RAL specification range is available, though this may incur an extra cost.
